Vision Statement: We imagine a community in which child abuse and neglect is eliminated, our families are strong, and our community is safe for future generations.

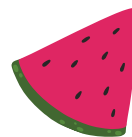
Mission Statement: To serve all families by providing opportunities and activities that promote healthy families and safe communities.

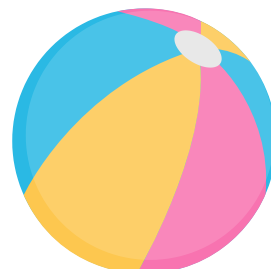

Home visits always start like a visit with a friend who checks in on what's happened since the last time you were together.

Likely, Family Support Specialists will develop other activities based on topics parents have asked to learn more about, such as child development (When will my baby start to crawl?) or health and safety topics. Parents are able to make toys or other fun projects to use with their infant.

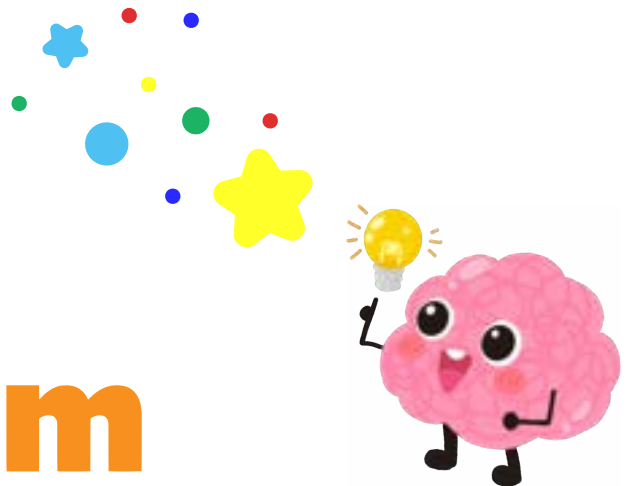
Family Support Specialists are always prepared to give families additional resources- if families feel it would be helpful- such as referrals to local service providers.

Available in the main lobby of the FRC building. Funded through a partnership with the St Croix Valley Food Bank and available to anyone in Burnett County.

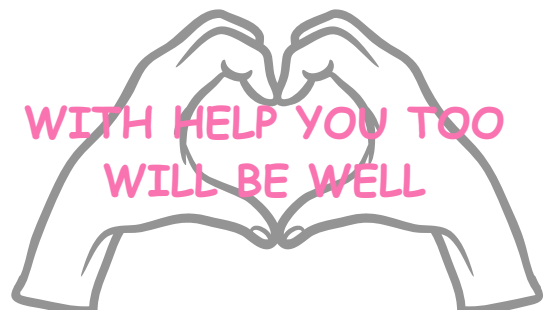
